We have been granted Ten Years at \$1.00 per year rental. The \$10.00 has been sent with the \$165.00 we had to pay for the preparation of the lease.
- 7. Judges are visiting the club on Saturday 24th October. Volunteers will be required, not only to assist the judges but also to man the kitchen. Donations of slices, cakes, uncut larger cakes and biscuits etc for the morning and afternoon tea for the judges and helpers could be appreciated.
