Keith - The Cullinan Diamond was found in 1905 near Pretoria in South Africa. It was 3106 carats & cut into nine stones. Keith presented two videos & a power point presentation. 2. Adrian - What is mindat.org—It is a free mineral database on the net & you can buy minerals on minfind.com. You can donate money to the site to help keep it going & add information which will help other users. The new "mineral of the month" is adamite - Zn2(Aso4)(OH) - orthorhombic system. (Noel passed around a sample). The Id exercise - ten minerals identified with an average correctness of six. The minerals were identified via notes on each mineral & photos of the ten minerals. The minerals were: muscovite, azurite, chalcopyrite, halite, jadeite, rhodocrosite, schorl, stibnite, chrysocolla & cassiterite.
